

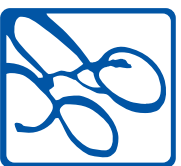
Pharmacy Services

A FULL RETAIL PHARMACY is available at the Atlanta and Onaway Clinic sites.

These pharmacies are open to the public, offering competitive pricing on prescription medication and over the counter medicine.

Discount medication and select non-prescription products are available for eligible patients of Thunder Bay Community Health Service.

If you are a patient of the health center and qualify for sliding fee, you are eligible for the "340 B" prescription program. The government has made this program available to Federally Qualified Health Centers throughout the United States to offer reduced costs on prescription drugs. These savings are passed on to Thunder Bay Community Health Service patients who get their prescriptions filled at a participating pharmacy.

What is a SCHOOL BASED health center?

A school based health center is a primary health care facility located within the school. Our center provides onsite medical, mental health, and dental services to promote the health and educational success of school age children and adolescents.

SERVICES OFFERED:

- Physical exams for school, sports, and college
- Well child/sick child visits
- Treatment for acute and chronic illness, and injury
- Immunizations and allergy shots
- Health education
- Dispensing of medication
- First Aid
- Behavioral health counseling
- Nutrition counseling
- Confidential services (as required by Michigan law)

Dispensing of birth control or contraceptives is prohibited under Michigan Department of Education law



Who can use the SCHOOL BASED health center?

The school based health center is available to students of the Onaway Area School district.

This includes: students of the school, Headstart, Early Childhood Education, Presque Isle Academy, parochial schools and home-schoolers.

Financial Savings

We can help you save money on health care costs: Thunder Bay Community Health Service offers discounted fees for medical, pharmacy and dental services, based on family size and income. Our Outreach Coordinator can assist with enrolling students into Medicaid, and the Michigan Children's Health Plans: "Healthy Kids" & "MiChild" depending upon the eligibility status of the family.
